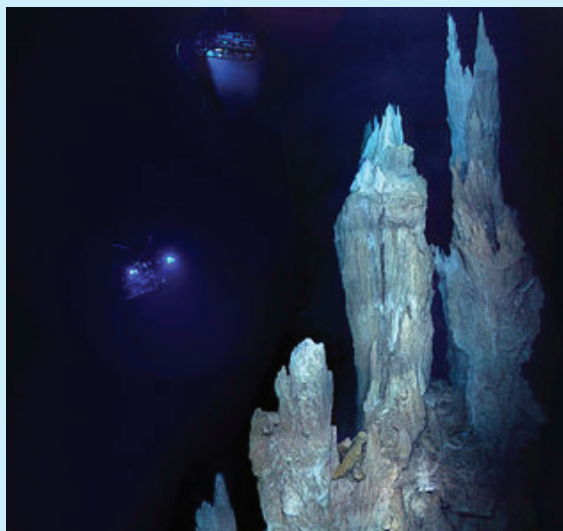

*Louise will share her experiences using concept mapping in her work.*

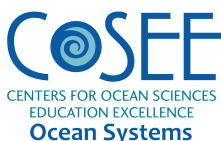
